EAS Writing Grant

Eligibility: ABDs in good academic standing who have produced at least one chapter and are planning to finish another in one semester.

Amount: \$2500

Requirements: During the tenure of the grant, students will start and complete ONE chapter of their dissertation. Eligible students will be notified after submitting their application that they will have four months to complete their chosen dissertation chapter. The writing grant will be paid out when the student submits the final completed draft on **March 15, 2025**, along with a plan including timeline, to complete the following chapter. Application materials and dissertation chapter drafts will NOT be circulated beyond the award committee to guarantee confidentiality.

To apply, students need to submit the following:

1. CV;
2. Dissertation abstract and chapter breakdown;
3. The proposed chapter to write during the grant period, detailed chapter outline, and timeline for completion;
4. Signed Supervisory Form.

To submit an application, students should send all application materials to EAS Grad Admin eas.grad@utoronto.ca and CC their supervisor by **Oct 31, 2024**. Decision will be made by Acting Chair in consultation with the Grad Chair Associate.
